## English

As writers, we will develop our persuasive writing techniques through designing, making and selling our own souvenirs, exploring the use of persuasive language and recording our own advertisements!

Linking to our topic, we will learn how to write a balanced argument, taking into account two contrasting points of view.

During our weekly guided-reading sessions, we will continue to enjoy a variety of different texts together. Along the way, we will develop our reading skills through focussed discussion, inference and questioning.

## Maths

As mathematicians, we will be focusing on shape, measurement, ratio and statistics. Alongside this, we will continue to develop strategies for recalling and using multiplication and division facts.

We will continue to develop our problem-solving skills across a variety of areas, expanding mathematical thinking beyond the classroom.

My maths Homework will continue to be set to reinforce concepts and topics taught in school.

## Religious Education

This term, our RE topic is titled, 'What do Hindu people believe about Dharm, Deity and Atman?'

We will explore various key themes, including;  
- *What Hindu's believe about God and reincarnation.*

## EMOTIONAL AWARENESS



We will demonstrate evidence of being ready to learn by showing confidence, eagerness, truthfulness and friendship. We will show teamwork through working as part of the school community.
