English

As writers, we will be looking at our topic writing non chronological reports based on our favourite sea creatures, a recount of our trip to Minehead beach by steam train, persuasive holiday brochures, Mousehole Mouse diaries and underwater narrative writing. We will be using all our learning from our morning phonics and SPAG sessions to support us with this. We will be broadening our vocabulary as a class with some fun games and our daily word. We will continue to develop cursive handwriting.

We will continue to challenge ourselves as readers at home & at school. In Guided Reading we will be focusing on asking and answering questions about a text using our reading strategies. We will be continuing to use our inference skills to think about how characters might be feeling or thinking.

Maths

As mathematicians we will be focusing on time and shape. Alongside this we will continue to use all 4 operations to solve problems mentally and use written methods to show reasoning. We will continue to work on our times tables 2,3,5 and 10 in order to speed up our recall of these.


Through our Welly Walks and cookery we will be exploring measurement.

We will be taking a trip on a steam train to Minehead beach to investigate how the seaside is different from our home locality. We will be discussing what makes an ideal seaside holiday destination and plan an enquiry about an issue affecting the seaside environment e.g. Impact of litter.

Physical Education

This term we will be starting are Athletics unit and practicing striking and hitting in our Games unit. We look forward to another fantastic Sports Day this year.
